Description

Sodium Benzoate Solution 30% w/w (E211) is used as a food preservative in wine. It is a clear solution made from food grade sodium benzoate and water.

Principle

Sodium Benzoate is also known under the E-number E211 which is the sodium salt of benzoic acid. The primary use for this product is as a food preservative and is effective in a variety of applications including food and wine. Sodium Benzoate is bacteriostatic and fungistatic under acidic conditions and will increase shelf life.

Guidelines for use

- Do not use with ascorbic acid
- Ensure suitability for the intended application
- In case of contact with skin and eyes wash immediately with plenty of water
- Wash away spillages with plenty of water
- Read the Safety Data Sheet prior to use

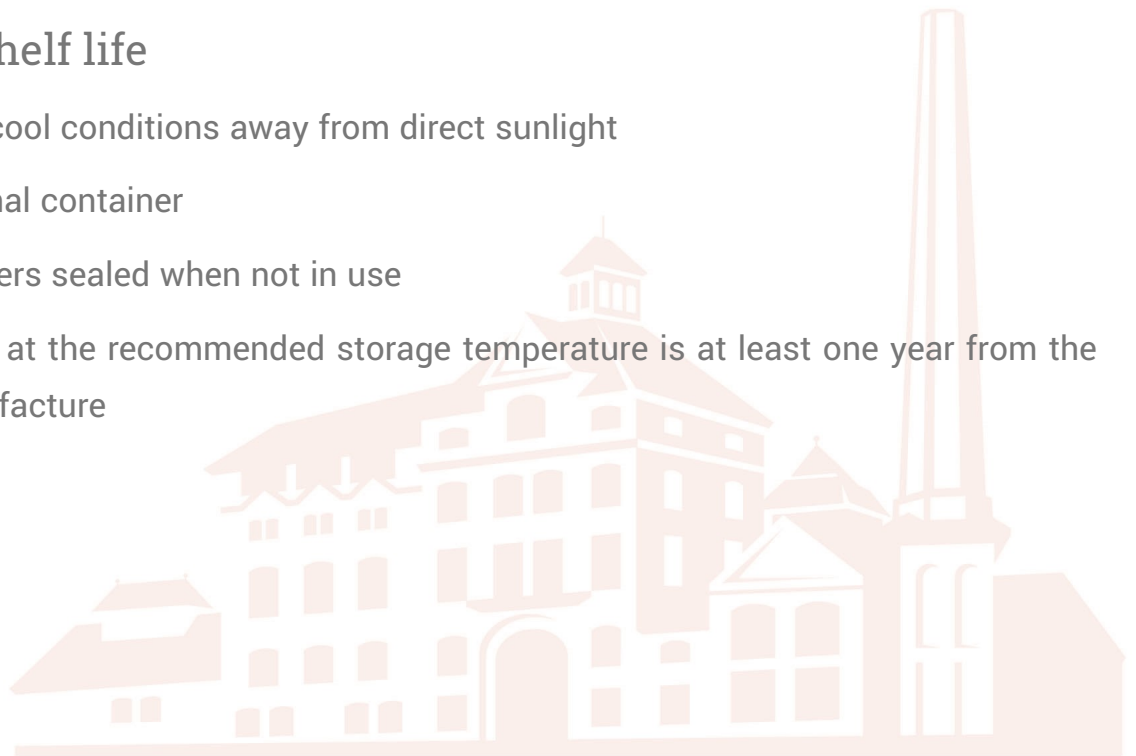
Application and rates of use

Sodium Benzoate is regulated in a variety of countries and usage rates will be dependant upon local regulations and the type of product that it is to be used in.

Before use of this product it is recommended that the FSA/EU/FDA etc are consulted to ensure the appropriate limits are observed. In the UK 70 ppm is the maximum level permitted in beer.

Storage and shelf life

- Store in dry, cool conditions away from direct sunlight
- Keep in original container
- Keep containers sealed when not in use
- The shelf life at the recommended storage temperature is at least one year from the date of manufacture
