STORAGE

Keep in original container. Keep containers sealed when not in use.

Temperature

Recommended storage temperature is 10°C - 20°C

Location

Store in cool conditions, away from direct sunlight.

Shelf Life

At the recommended storage conditions, three years from date of manufacture.

Application & Rates of Use

The product can be used as an addition to beer, wine and cider as a preservative, or for example as a means of preserving microbiological stability in empty casks. Suitable rates lie between 10 and 50 ppm sulphur dioxide (SO₂).

1.5 g of Sodium Metabisulphite per hectolitre will add 10 ppm sulphur dioxide (SO₂)

The product is typically made up as an aqueous solution, after which it can be added to the beverage.

Guidelines For Use

- · Check that the product is within its shelf life before use
- · Read the Safety Data Sheet prior to use
- · Check local, up to date allergen legislation prior to use
- The maximum level permitted for SO_2 in cask conditioned beer is 50 ppm. In all other beers only 20 ppm SO_2 is permitted
- Sulphur dioxide and sulphites at concentrations of more than 10 mg/kg or 10 mg/L expressed as SO₂ must be labelled as allergenic
- · Not suitable for cans, as SO2 can react with the lining of beverage cans.
